

PT Multi Bintang Indonesia Tbk Announces New President Director and Changes of Board of Commissioners

Jakarta, August 15th 2019 – PT Multi Bintang Indonesia Tbk (MLBI) today announced that in the Extraordinary General Meeting appointed Murk Hidde Spits as the new President Director replacing Chin Kean Huat (Michael Chin) who had completed his tenure after more than 6 years in Indonesia. In addition, Kenneth Choo Tay Sian and also Bartholomeus A.C. van den Huijsen was also appointed as a member of the Company's Board of Commissioners. This appointment has been effective since the close of the Extraordinary General Meeting today, August 15th, 2019.

Before joining Multi Bintang, Murk Spits served as the General Manager for the past four years in Vrumona, one of the largest soda, water and juice producers in the Netherlands which is also part of the HEINEKEN Company. Previously, he was the Senior Regional Finance Director for HEINEKEN America where he oversaw all HEINEKEN operations in North America, South America including the Caribbean islands. It is a homecoming for Bartholomeus as he has previously served as a Finance Manager at Multi Bintang, before being transferred to the Netherlands and Italy.

Kenneth Choo Tay Sian currently serves as Managing Director of HEINEKEN Asia Pacific Pte Ltd and is responsible for overseeing the growth and development a number of HEINEKEN operating companies in the Asia Pacific region. Joined at HEINEKEN Asia Pacific Pte Ltd in 2003, he played an important role in the acquisition of Asia Pacific Breweries Limited (APB) by HEINEKEN which was followed by a smooth integration process. During the period of 2013 - 2014, Kenneth held several important positions in the finance section in a number of HEINEKEN operating company within Asia Pacific regions, where in 2014, he held Regional
